Education / Training Bursary

The aim of the bursary is to offer financial assistance to access specialist training for up to the sum of £250.00.

- Applicants must be aged between 10 and 18 years old on 1st January 2019 and be a current NPS member in their own right or their parent/guardian must be a member.
- Funding may be requested for:
 - A) A series of lessons with a new instructor, working at a higher level;
 - B) Cross-discipline tuition (e.g. a WHP rider who wishes to take lessons with an approved eventing instructor);
 - C) Attendance on a short, intensive course with an approved instructor.
- The instructor will be asked to raise an invoice for their work and funds will be paid direct to the instructor as part or full payment for their time.
- Candidates will be evaluated in November December 2018, presentation to be made at the 2019 AGM with funding tranches to be paid throughout 2019.
- The successful candidate will be presented with their bursary at the 2019 AGM and will be
 asked to write a short report for the 2019 NPS Review, explaining what they did with the
 funds and how it has benefitted them.
